

## Supporting Young People with Disabilities and/or Learning Difficulties

**One Day Accredited Training Course (level 3)**

**£100 Bursary available for voluntary sector learners**

This course aims to enable those who work with disabled young people (paid and volunteers) to understand the issues affecting the young people they work with, how to support them and relevant statutory and legal frameworks. It will also provide an excellent networking opportunity for learners from a variety of organisations in Surrey and the South East.

**LEARNING OUTCOMES:** On successful completion the learner will be able to:

- Recognise the issues and barriers facing young people with disabilities
- Describe the sources of specialist help that can aid their work
- Understand how to provide support that encourages young people to maximise their own potential and independence
- Appreciate the impact of legislation on the young people they work with
- Recognise the benefits of promoting the Social Model of Disability
- Share good practice and networking opportunities

**ACCREDITATION:** on completion of a portfolio of evidence learners will achieve 3 credits of the ABC Level 3 Working with Vulnerable Young People qualification. This process will be supported by an assessor who will give individual one to one support.

**COST: £180 \*\*\*** 20 bursaries of £100 per person which will reduce the cost to £80 are available for learners from the voluntary sector from the NCVYS Progress Project.

To be eligible for this you need to have registered with us by **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March**. We will then help you through the registration process with NCVYS to draw down the funding.
